E-SCOOTER SAFETY

There were approximately **38.5 MILLION** e-scooter trips taken in 2018.



Most injuries occur between riders **AGED 18 TO 34.**



A January 2020 study by the University of California, San Francisco found the number of **SCOOTER-RELATED INJURIES** in the U.S. more than **DOUBLED** between 2014 and 2018.

➤ The e-scooter injury rate among the U.S. population climbed from **6 PER 100,000** to **19 PER 100,000 RIDERS** during that time.

RULES OF THE ROAD

It is **ILLEGAL** to ride e-scooters on **SIDEWALKS** in California.



DRIVER'S LICENSE or **LEARNER'S PERMIT** needed to ride.



One scooter,
ONE PERSON.

Always leave e-scooters in designated **DROP-OFF AREAS.**



DO NOT BLOCK sidewalks, curb ramps, doorways, or driveways.
